

REQUEST FORM: EXEMPTION FROM COVID-19 VACCINE—OTHER REASONS

To protect the health and safety of our community, Red River College (RRC) is making COVID-19 vaccination a condition to come on campus, as well as any space owned or occupied by the College. Refer to Policy E14-COVID-19 Procedures (<u>https://www.rrc.ca/legal/policies/covid-19-procedures</u>) for full details.

RRC will consider on an individual basis requests for exemptions from students, residents and employees on ground other than medical or creed/religious needs. All requests will be reviewed by RRC Safety and Health Services ("SHS") whose determination will be final.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

- Requests for exemptions on other grounds will only be considered upon completion and presentation of this form.
- · Completion and submission of this form does not guarantee approval of the exemption sought.
- The duration of the exemption is at the sole determination of RRC. Individuals approved for an exemption may request an extension, if required.
- To continue to protect the health and safety of the campus community, at the sole discretion of RRC, students
 or employees with an approved exemption to being vaccinated may be accommodated through reasonable
 alternative measures. Where COVID-19 testing is required, and the exemption is not based upon a protected
 characteristic, the Applicant will be responsible for obtaining test results and providing them to the College on
 the designated interval.
- Individuals with an approved exemption will be notified in writing of the approval and associated alternative measures through their RRC email. Please allow adequate time for a response.
- · Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- Decisions by SHS are final. Individuals are permitted to reapply if new documentation and/or information becomes available.
- This exemption only applies to requests for exemption from RRC's COVID-19 vaccination policy. If youare seeking academic or workplace accommodations for other purposes, you will be required to make a separate application in accordance with existing procedures. If you have a previously approved accommodation, you must still submit this form if you wish to be considered for a COVID-19 vaccination exemption.
- DO NOT COME TO ANY COLLEGE CAMPUS IN PERSON UNLESS YOU HAVE RECEIVED WRITTEN CONFIRMATION THAT YOUR REQUEST IS APPROVED AND YOU HAVE COMPLIED WITH THE ALTERNATIVE MEASURES; OR YOU HAVE BEEN VACCINATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH POLICY E-14
